MESSAGE FROM AIDE'S CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD, PRESIDENT & CEO, ANTONIO O. COJUANGCO

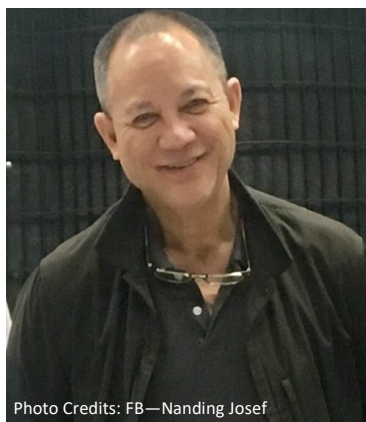


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Greetings to all our students!

Each year, we feel delighted to see groups of student who are able to obtain their degree in our institution as it reflects the success and realization of our mission — to democratize access to higher education and make more inclusive and equitable education to many Filipinos.

When we conceptualized the founding of a non-traditional distance higher learning institution in the early part of the 80's, which was then called Asian University of Independent Studies (AUIS), we at AIDE, already thought of providing a higher education that is more flexible and open, one that is totally different from the conventional institutions. This is to widen access of the underserved and marginalized Filipinos to quality higher education. Forty years ago, when we started to make a paradigm shift in education, we were so determined to play a catalytic role in providing alternative solutions to traditional education which is viewed to be more structured, rigid and limited. Seeing all of you graduate, I must say that all our efforts have paid off. The institutionalization of AIDE in 1982, gave birth to the teaching-learning arrangements in which the learner and the teacher are separated by space, place and time. To make education equitable, we created a mode of delivering education and instruction to learners who are not physically present in a traditional setting of classroom through the use of open and distance learning (ODL) philosophy. That is also the time when we were able to reach many sectors as OFWs, government employees, private corporations' employees who were not able to finish school but were given the opportunity to pursue college education through AIDE's open and distance education system. Truly, AIDE has helped many Filipino students each year.

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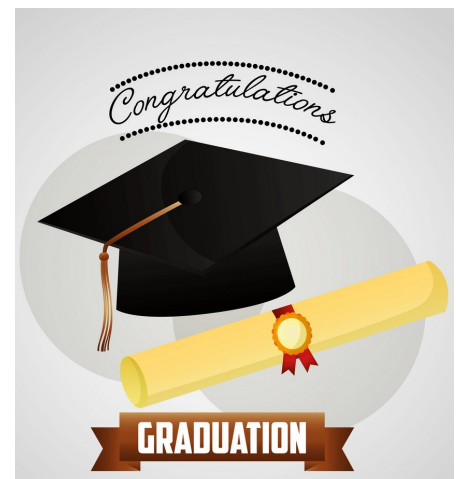
