What are the subjects under the Professional Major courses of BSBA Operations Management (OM)?

The following are the professional courses of the BSBA –OM curriculum. These courses lay the fundamental concepts that every business administration student has to know in the field of business.

What are the elective subjects of the BSBA—OM)?

Following CHED Memo 17, series of 2017, the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) allows Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to enhance their BSBA curriculum by providing electives based on the vision and mission of the college or school. According to CHED (as stated in CMO 17, s.2017), the school may offer other electives that may help student pursue his or her specialization. Given this leeway, AIDE may choose from among the list of modules/subjects from the other courses whichever is beneficial to its students such as (but not limited to) the following subjects:

1. Entrepreneurial Management
2. Marketing Management
3. Financial Management
4. Management Information Systems (MIS) or
5. International Trade

What are the course description of the Professional subjects under the BSBA OM program?

1. INVENTORY MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL

This course explains the dynamics of inventory management's principles, concepts, and techniques as they relate to the entire supply chain, including customer demand, distribution, and product transformation processes. The interrelationships of all functions are examined. Emphasis is placed on the ramifications of inventory management. The methods and techniques for reducing the cost of holding goods while providing an efficient and effective service to their customers are covered.

The second part of the subject will deal with inventory control which will generally help students to understand what inventory control is, its importance, and its challenges. It will also provide tips for inventory control, and discuss some inventory control systems and techniques.
